## Aldinga Beach Primary School

### Goals

To increase the percentage of students attaining and retaining SEA and high band in Numeracy as identified in NAPLAN results in Year 3 and 5.

### Challenge of Practice

If we develop consistency of high yield practices and strong conceptual understanding with teachers then we will increase the percentage of students retaining and attaining SEA and high band as measured by NAPLAN data.

### Success Criteria

- Students demonstrating their understandings through multimodal methods of assessments
- Students use Big Ideas in Number concepts
- Students engage in problem solving and share their thinking in multiple ways
- Each student develops a more positive mindset towards maths
- Students will share their thinking using mathematical language (within task and reflection)
- Students will articulate their learning in relation to learning intention and success criteria
- Students will be able to articulate strategies they are using to engage with texts.
- Students will be able to make connections between the grapheme, phoneme and the name of the letter
- Students will identify the grapheme and phonemes for letter using this terminology
- Students will be able to identify, describe and employ the features of subject specific textual genres.
- Students will more consistently use tier 2 and 3 vocabulary in speaking and writing.

To increase the percentage of students achieving SEA and high band in reading and writing as demonstrated in the NAPLAN data for Year 3 and 5
